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Jonesville Academy S.T.E.A.M. Day set for National Corvette Museum

Jonesville Academy, a program of nonprofits Boys to Men Leadership Group and For a Real Change, will enjoy its annual S.T.E.A.M. Day at the National Corvette Museum on February 24, 2024, thanks to a sponsorship from AT&T.

The annual S.T.E.A.M. Day, which stands for science, technology, engineering, arts, and math, creates a space for the scholars in Jonesville Academy to learn about one or more areas. To fit within the S.T.E.A.M. focus, the National Corvette Museum staff has coordinated activities that involve designing corvettes and corvette clay modeling, and a competitive race with the model cars. Ninth-grade scholars will engage in 3D design and simulation. Up to 80 Jonesville Academy scholars are expected to participate in S.T.E.A.M. Day. The scholars represent youth in grades 3-9 from 22 schools in five school districts with many youth from underrepresented backgrounds. While most scholars attend schools in Bowling Green Independent School District (BGISD) and Warren County Public Schools (WCPS), scholars also travel from Barren County Public Schools, Ohio County Public Schools, and Russellville Independent Schools to participate in the Jonesville Academy.

Jonesville Academy is grateful to AT&T for sponsoring the STEAM Day activities, and thanks to Omega Psi Phi Theta Alpha Alpha Chapter for providing lunch. Both groups will have volunteers there to assist scholars and participate in all the activities the National Corvette Museum has planned.
